- Section 1. Section 230.07 of the penal law, as amended by chapter 74 of the laws of 2007, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 S 230.07 Patronizing a prostitute; defense.
- In any prosecution for patronizing a prostitute in the first or second degrees, it is [a] AN AFFIRMATIVE defense that the defendant did not have reasonable grounds to believe that the person was less than the age specified.
- S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
