AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to prohibiting accountants from providing financial or accounting services to certain corporations audited by such accountant

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 7411 2 to read as follows:

- S 7411. PROHIBITION. NO CERTIFIED PUBLIC ACCOUNTANT, PUBLIC ACCOUNTANT, OR EMPLOYEE, PARTNER OR ASSOCIATE OF SUCH ACCOUNTANT SHALL PROVIDE ACCOUNTING SERVICES, OTHER THAN THE PROVISION OF AN AUDIT, TO ANY CORPORATION, THE SHARES OR BONDS OF WHICH ARE PUBLICLY TRADED, UPON WHICH SUCH ACCOUNTANT HAS CONDUCTED AN AUDIT WITHIN THE PREVIOUS FIVE YEARS. THE BOARD OF REGENTS SHALL PROMULGATE ANY RULES AND REGULATIONS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT THIS SECTION.
- 10 S 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth day after 11 it shall have become a law; provided that any rules and regulations 12 necessary to implement the provisions of this act on its effective date 13 are authorized and directed to be promulgated on or before such date.
