AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating New York state route 375 from the intersection of New York state route 28 in West Hurley to the intersection of New York state route 212 in Woodstock as the "Levon Helm Memorial Boulevard"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 344-b to 2 read as follows:
 - S 344-B. PORTION OF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM TO BE DESIGNATED AS THE "LEVON HELM MEMORIAL BOULEVARD". ALL THAT PORTION OF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM CONSTITUTING NEW YORK STATE ROUTE 375, BEGINNING AT THE INTERSECTION OF NEW YORK STATE ROUTE 28 IN WEST HURLEY, COUNTY OF ULSTER AND CONTINUING NORTH 2.92 MILES TO ITS INTERSECTION OF NEW YORK STATE ROUTE 212 IN WOODSTOCK, SHALL BE DESIGNATED AND KNOWN AS THE "LEVON HELM MEMORIAL BOULEVARD".
- S 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the installation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system as designated pursuant to section one of this act. However, to avoid confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the designation called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be one of ceremonial nature and the official name of such highway shall not be changed as a result of this act.
- 17 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
