- AN ACT to amend the criminal procedure law, in relation to designating certain persons appointed by a county sheriff's office as peace officers

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 2.10 of the criminal procedure law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision 84 to read as follows:
- 3 84. PERSONS APPOINTED BY A COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE, OUTSIDE OF NEW WHEN ACTING PURSUANT TO THEIR SPECIAL DUTIES SERVING AS 4 YORK CITY, 5 UNIFORMED DEPUTIES WORKING IN A SPECIALIZED FUNCTION INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO MOUNTED PATROL, MARINE PATROL, SNOWMOBILE PATROL, ATV PATROL, 6 SCIENTIFIC, OR AVIATION. SUCH PERSONS MUST HAVE SUCCESSFULLY 7 FORENSIC, 8 COMPLETED PEACE OFFICER TRAINING PURSUANT TO SECTION 2.30 OF THIS ARTI-CLE. NOTHING IN THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL BE DEEMED TO AUTHORIZE SUCH OFFI-9 CER OR AGENT TO CARRY, POSSESS, REPAIR, OR DISPOSE OF A FIREARM UNLESS 10 THE APPROPRIATE LICENSE THEREFOR HAS BEEN ISSUED PURSUANT TO 11 SECTION 400.00 OF THE PENAL LAW. 12
- 13 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
