AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to participation by independent living centers in minority and women owned business requirements

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 13 of section 310 of the executive amended by chapter 506 of the laws of 2009, is amended to read as follows:

13. "State contract" shall mean: (a) a written agreement or purchase order instrument, providing for a total expenditure in excess of twenty-five thousand dollars, whereby a contracting agency is committed to expend or does expend funds in return for labor, services including but limited to legal, financial and other professional equipment, materials or any combination of the foregoing, supplies, EXCLUDING THOSE SERVICES THAT ARE ESTABLISHED TO PROVIDE PERSONNEL FOR THE OPERATIONS AND PROGRAMS CONTRACTED TO THOSE ORGANIZATIONS AUTHORIZED ARTICLE TWENTY-THREE-A OF THE EDUCATION LAW, to be performed for, or rendered or furnished to the contracting agency; (b) a written agreement in excess of one hundred thousand dollars whereby a contracting agency committed to expend or does expend funds for the acquisition, construction, demolition, replacement, major repair or renovation of real property and improvements thereon; and (c) a written agreement in excess of one hundred thousand dollars whereby the owner of a assisted housing project is committed to expend or does expend funds for acquisition, construction, demolition, replacement, major repair or renovation of real property and improvements thereon for such project.

S 2. This act shall take effect immediately; provided, however, 23 amendments to subdivision 13 of section 310 of the executive law 24 made by section one of this act shall not affect the expiration of such section and shall be deemed to expire therewith.
