AN ACT to amend the civil practice law and rules, in relation to a stay of the enforcement of a determination involving a permit or approval in connection with the development or construction of residential housing

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 7805 of the civil practice law and rules is amended 2 to read as follows:

3 S 7805. Stay. On the motion of any party or on its own initiative, the 4 court may stay further proceedings, or the enforcement of any determi-5 nation under review, upon terms including notice, security and payment of costs, except that the enforcement of an order or judgment granted by 6 7 the appellate division in a proceeding under this article may be staved only by order of the appellate division or the court of appeals. Unless 8 otherwise ordered, security given on a stay is effective in favor of a 9 10 person subsequently joined as a party under section 7802. THE COURT IN ISSUING A STAY OF THE ENFORCEMENT OF A DETERMINATION INVOLVING A 11 PERMIT APPROVAL IN CONNECTION WITH THE DEVELOPMENT OR CONSTRUCTION OF RESI-12 OR DENTIAL HOUSING SHALL REQUIRE THE POSTING OF SECURITY IN AN AMOUNT 13 THE COURT SHALL DEEM PROPER. 14

15 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
