AN ACT to amend the criminal procedure law, in relation to granting peace officer status to public safety officers of Co-op City in Bronx county

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 2.10 of the criminal procedure law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision 84 to read as follows:

3 84. (A) PERSONS SERVING AS PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICERS FOR A LIMITED PROFIT HOUSING COMPLEX KNOWN AS "CO-OP CITY" IN BRONX COUNTY TO PREVENT 4 CRIME 5 AND ENFORCE THELAW WHILE ACTING IN CONNECTION WITH THEIR SPECIALIZED б DUTIES OF EMPLOYMENT; PROVIDED HOWEVER, THAT NOTHING IN THIS SUBDIVISION 7 SHALL BE DEEMED TO AUTHORIZE ANY SUCH OFFICER TO CARRY, POSSESS, REPAIR 8 OR DISPOSE OF A FIREARM UNLESS THE APPROPRIATE LICENSE THEREFOR HAS BEEN 9 ISSUED PURSUANT TO SECTION 400.00 OF THE PENAL LAW.

10 (B) PRIOR TO PERFORMING THE DUTIES PERMITTED UNDER PARAGRAPH (A) OF 11 THIS SUBDIVISION, A PERSON MUST HAVE SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED THE TRAINING 12 REQUIREMENT SET FORTH IN SECTION 2.30 OF THIS ARTICLE AND ANY ADDITIONAL 13 PEACE OFFICER TRAINING REQUIRED BY THE MUNICIPAL POLICE TRAINING COUNCIL 14 IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION EIGHT HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE OF THE EXECUTIVE 15 LAW.

16 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeed-17 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
