- 1 Section 1. Section 135.50 of the penal law is amended by adding a new 2 closing paragraph to read as follows:
- THERE SHALL BE A REBUTTABLE PRESUMPTION UNDER SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS SECTION THAT A PERSON ACTS WITH INTENT TO PERMANENTLY REMOVE THE VICTIM FROM THIS STATE WHEN THE PERSON REMOVES THE VICTIM FROM THE STATE FOR A CONTINUOUS PERIOD FOR THIRTY DAYS OR MORE.
- 7 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
