AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to the access of certain information contained in the central register of child abuse and maltreatment

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subparagraph (iv) of paragraph (b) of subdivision 1 of section 424-a of the social services law is renumbered subparagraph (v) and a new subparagraph (iv) is added to read as follows:

4 (IV) A CAMP SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE THIRTEEN-A OR THIR-5 PUBLIC HEALTH LAW MAY INQUIRE OF THE OFFICE OF CHILDREN TEEN-B OF THEAND FAMILY SERVICES, AND THE OFFICE SHALL, UPON RECEIPT OF SUCH б INOUIRY 7 SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF PARAGRAPH (E) OF THIS SUBDIVISION, AND INFORM SUCH AGENCY AND THE SUBJECT OF THE INQUIRY WHETHER ANY PERSON WHO 8 9 IS ACTIVELY BEING CONSIDERED FOR EMPLOYMENT AND WHO WILL HAVE THE POTEN-TIAL FOR REGULAR AND SUBSTANTIAL CONTACT WITH CHILDREN WHO ARE CARED FOR 10 BY THE AGENCY, IS THE SUBJECT OF AN INDICATED CHILD ABUSE AND 11 MALTREAT-MENT REPORT ON FILE WITH THE STATEWIDE CENTRAL REGISTER OF CHILD ABUSE 12 13 AND MALTREATMENT.
