AN ACT to authorize Jay Vandermark, Jr. to be employed as a part-time police officer by the village of Deposit, in the county of Broome

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any provision of the civil service law, or any rule or regulation adopted pursuant thereto, to the contrary, the village of Deposit, in the county of Broome, acting by and through its board of trustees, is authorized to employ, as a part-time village police officer without competitive examination, Jay Vandermark, Jr., who is also employed by the department of public works of such village as a full-time equipment operator.

S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
