AN ACT to amend the alcoholic beverage control law, in relation to the authority of the state liquor authority to promulgate rules and regulations; and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon expiration thereof

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Section 17 of the alcoholic beverage control law is amended by adding a new subdivision 10 to read as follows:
- 10. TO PROMULGATE ANY RULE OR REGULATION NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT ANY PROVISION OF THIS CHAPTER.
