AN ACT to amend the state finance law, in relation to the state procurement council

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Paragraph a of subdivision 1 of section 161 of the state finance law, as amended by chapter 452 of the laws of 2012, is amended to read as follows:

3 a. The state procurement council shall continuously strive to improve 5 the state's procurement process. Such council shall consist of twentyone members, including the commissioner, the state comptroller, the 7 director of the budget, the chief diversity officer and the commissioner 8 economic development, or their respective designees; seven members 9 who shall be the heads of other large and small state agencies chosen by the governor, or their respective designees; one member, appointed by 10 governor, representing a not-for-profit New York-based organization 11 12 engaged in the marketing and/or promotion of New York grown farm and agricultural products or a not-for-profit New York-based organization 13 14 engaged solely in the advocacy, marketing and/or promotion of organic York grown farm and agricultural products to be limited to a two 15 16 year term; and eight at large members appointed as follows: three 17 appointed by the temporary president of the senate, one of whom shall be 18 representative of local government and one of whom shall be a repre-19 sentative of private business; three appointed by the speaker 20 assembly, one of whom shall be a representative of local government and one of whom shall be a representative of private business; one appointed 21 by the minority leader of the senate; and, one appointed by the minority 22 23 leader of the assembly; and two non-voting observers appointed as follows: one appointed by the temporary president of the senate and one 25 appointed by the speaker of the assembly. The non-voting observers shall

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be provided, contemporaneously, all documentation and materials distributed to members. The council shall be chaired by the commissioner and shall meet at least quarterly. IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER MEMBERS NAMED HEREINABOVE, EX OFFICIO MEMBERS SHALL INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING NON-VOTING MEMBERS OR THEIR RESPECTIVE DESIGNEES: THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF A STATE-WIDE BUSINESS ASSOCIATION, AND THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF A STATEWIDE ASSOCIATION REPRESENTING LOCAL GOVERNMENTS.

- S 2. Subdivision 2 of section 161 of the state finance law is amended by adding a new paragraph o to read as follows:
- O. RECOMMEND TO THE COMMISSIONER NECESSARY LEGISLATIVE CHANGES OR MODIFICATIONS TO EXISTING OR PROPOSED RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES THAT WOULD INCREASE PARTICIPATION BY RESIDENT BUSINESSES IN STATE CONTRACTS, AND CREATE MODEL LANGUAGE TO BE USED BY AGENCIES WHEN ISSUING REQUESTS FOR BIDS OR PROPOSALS TO OTHER SOLICITATIONS OR OFFERS THAT WOULD INCREASE THE ABILITY OF RESIDENT BUSINESSES TO PARTICIPATE IN STATE PROCUREMENTS.
- S 3. Subdivision 4 of section 161 of the state finance law, as added by chapter 83 of the laws of 1995, is amended to read as follows:
- 19 4. The commissioner shall report to the governor, the legislature and the director of the budget, AND THE STATE PROCUREMENT COUNCIL, by Decem-20 thirty-first, nineteen hundred ninety-five and thereafter annually 21 on any modifications to or rejections of the rules and regulations 22 proposed by the council, AND SHALL PROVIDE QUARTERLY UPDATES ON ANY 23 INITIATIVES THAT SIGNIFICANTLY AFFECT STATE CONTRACTS INCLUDING 24 25 LIMITATION STRATEGIC SOURCING OR SIMILAR INITIATIVES, OR PURSUANT TO 26 REQUESTS MADE CONCERNING ANY PROCUREMENT INITIATIVES BY THE COUNCIL, THE 27 DEPARTMENT, OR THE COMMISSIONER.
- 28 S 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
