AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to establishing certain substances as schedule I stimulants controlled substances

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Paragraphs 9 and 10 of subdivision (f) of schedule I of
2 section 3306 of the public health law, as added by chapter 130 of the
3 laws of 2011, are amended and fourteen new paragraphs 11 through 24 are
4 added to read as follows:
5 (9) 4-METHYL-N-METHYLCATHINONE OR 4-Methylmethcathinone, also known as
6 Mephedrone.
7 (10) 3,4-METHYLENEDIOXYPYROVALERONE OR Methylenedioxypyrovalerone,
8 also known as MDPV.
9 (11) 3,4-METHYLENEDIOXY-N-METHYLCATHINONE (SOME OTHER NAMES: METHY-
10 LONE).
11 (12) 4-METHOXYMETHCATHINONE.
12 (13) 3-FLUOROMETHCATHINONE.
13 (14) 4-FLUOROMETHCATHINONE.
14 (15) ETHYLPROPION (ETHCATHINONE).
15 (16) 2-(2,5-DIMETHOXY-4-ETHYLPHENYL)ETHANAMINE (2C-E).
16 (17) 2-(2,5-DIMETHOXY-4-METHYLPHENYL)ETHANAMINE (2C-D).
17 (18) 2-(4-CHLORO-2,5-DIMETHOXYPHENYL)ETHANAMINE (2C-C).
18 (19) 2-(4-IODO-2,5-DIMETHOXYPHENYL)ETHANAMINE (2C-I).
19 (20) 2-{4-(ETHYLTHIO)-2,5-DIMETHOXYPHENYL}ETHANAMINE (2C-T-2).
