AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to payments to rural hospitals designated as critical access hospitals

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 2-a of section 2807 of the public health law is amended by adding a new paragraph (j) to read as follows:

- (J) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS SUBDIVISION OR ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW TO THE CONTRARY AND, SUBJECT TO AN APPROPRIATION THEREFOR, ON AND AFTER APRIL FIRST, TWO THOUSAND FOURTEEN, RATES FOR DIAGNOSTIC AND TREATMENT CENTER SERVICES, **EMERGENCY** SERVICES, GENERAL HOSPITAL OUTPATIENT SERVICES, **AMBULATORY** SURGICAL AND REFERRED AMBULATORY SERVICES, PROVIDED BY A RURAL HOSPITAL SERVICES DESIGNATED AS A CRITICAL ACCESS HOSPITAL IN ACCORDANCE WITH TITLE THE FEDERAL SOCIAL SECURITY ACT SHALL BE EQUAL TO ONE HUNDRED ONE PERCENT OF THE REASONABLE COSTS OF A FACILITY IN PROVIDING SUCH SERVICES TO PATIENTS ELIGIBLE FOR PAYMENTS MADE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SUBDIVI-COSTS SHALL BE DETERMINED IN A MANNER CONSISTENT WITH REASONABLE THAT USED TO DETERMINE PAYMENT FOR OUTPATIENT CRITICAL ACCESS HOSPITAL PROVIDED TO BENEFICIARIES OF TITLE XVIII OF THE FEDERAL SOCIAL SERVICES SECURITY ACT. FOR FACILITIES WITHOUT ADEQUATE COST EXPERIENCE, SHALL BE BASED ON BUDGETED COSTS SUBSEQUENTLY ADJUSTED TO ONE HUNDRED ONE PERCENT OF REASONABLE ACTUAL COSTS.
- 19 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately; provided, however, that 20 the implementation of the provisions of this act shall be subject to the 21 appropriation of moneys specifically for the purposes thereof.
