AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to recordkeeping requirements for second-hand dealers, scrap processors and pawnbrokers

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The general business law is amended by adding a new article 5-B to read as follows:

ARTICLE 5-B

RECORDKEEPING REQUIREMENTS FOR SECOND-HAND DEALERS, SCRAP PROCESSORS AND PAWNBROKERS

AN ACCURATE DESCRIPTION OF EACH ARTICLE PURCHASED OR SOLD, INCLUD-34 ING TYPE OF ARTICLE, MANUFACTURER, MAKE, MODEL NUMBER, SERIAL NUMBER, 35 INTERNATIONAL MOBILE EQUIPMENT IDENTIFIER, ELECTRONIC SERIAL NUMBER, 36 37 MOBILE EQUIPMENT IDENTIFIER, INSCRIPTIONS OR DISTINGUISHING MARKS, AND 38 ONE OR MORE DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPHS REASONABLY CAPTURING THE LIKENESS OF THE 39 ARTICLE.

40 NOTWITHSTANDING ANY INCONSISTENT PROVISION OF THIS SUBDIVISION, SUCH ELECTRONIC RECORD SHALL IN ANY EVENT CONTAIN THE INFORMATION SPECIFIED 41 IN SECTION FORTY-THREE OF THIS CHAPTER. 42

43 3. THE PAWNBROKER SHALL ACQUIRE AND MAINTAIN IN GOOD WORKING ORDER THE 44 ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT NECESSARY TO CREATE AND MAINTAIN THE ELECTRONIC 45 RECORDS REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO A COMPUT-ER WITH INTERNET CONNECTION, AN ELECTRONIC SIGNATURE PAD AND A DIGITAL 46 47 CAMERA UTILIZING A FILE FORMAT DESIGNATED BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE.

NOTHING 4 ANY RECORDKEEPING REQUIREMENT IMPOSED BY OR PURSUANT TO ANY OTHER APPLI-5 CABLE STATE OR LOCAL LAW. 6 6.
