AN ACT to amend the New York State urban development corporation act, in relation to certain grants for assistance to provide advanced manufacturing employers with a competitive workforce

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 16-m of section 1 of chapter 174
2 of the laws of 1968, constituting the New York state urban development
3 corporation act, is amended by adding a new paragraph (o) to read as
4 follows:
5 (O) GRANTS TO EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS, NOT-FOR-PROFITS, INDUSTRY
6 PUBLIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIPS, AND INDIVIDUALS FOR ASSISTANCE LEADING TO
7 APPROPRIATE TRAINING AND CERTIFICATION TO ENTER THE ADVANCED MANUFACTUR-
8 ING FIELD AND TO PROVIDE ADVANCED MANUFACTURING EMPLOYERS WITH A COMPET-
9 ITIVE WORKFORCE. THE CORPORATION SHALL CREATE CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBLE
10 APPLICANTS INCLUDING PREFERENCE FOR PROGRAMS THAT FOSTER LOCAL AND
11 REGIONAL PUBLIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIPS AND OFFER TRAINING IN AN INDUSTRY
12 RECOGNIZED PROGRAM AND/OR CERTIFICATION PROGRAM THAT DEMONSTRATES THE
13 PROSPECTIVE EMPLOYEE'S READINESS, UPON COMPLETION OF THE PROGRAM, TO
14 ENTER THE DESIRED FIELD WITH THE REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE OF ADVANCED MANUFAC-
15 TURING EQUIPMENT AND PROCESSES.
16 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately; provided that the amend-
17 ments to section 16-m of section 1 of chapter 174 of the laws of 1968,
18 constituting the New York state urban development corporation act, made
19 by section one of this act shall not affect the expiration of such
20 section and shall be deemed to expire therewith.
