AN ACT to amend the multiple residence law, in relation to minimum heating requirements

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Section 173 of the multiple residence law, as amended by chapter 225 of the laws of 1982, is amended to read as follows:
 - 173. Heating. 1. Every new dwelling shall be provided with heat [in all living rooms], OR THE FACILITIES OR EQUIPMENT THEREFOR, PORTIONS OF THE DWELLING USED OR OCCUPIED FOR LIVING PURPOSES sufficient to maintain the minimum temperatures AS required by local law, ordinances, rules, or regulation, or by the local public health officer[, provided, minimum shall, however, that such temperature notwithstanding]. NOTWITHSTANDING the provisions of subdivision one section three hundred twenty-nine of this chapter, [be] DURING THE PERI-OD BETWEEN OCTOBER FIRST AND MAY THIRTY-FIRST, SUCH MINIMUM TEMPERATURES (A) sixty-eight degrees Fahrenheit during the hours between SHALL BE: six o'clock in the morning and ten o'clock in the evening during months between October first and May thirty-first, whenever the outdoor temperature falls below fifty-five degrees Fahrenheit; AND (B) AT LEAST DEGREES FAHRENHEIT BETWEEN THE HOURS OF TEN O'CLOCK IN THE FIFTY-FIVE EVENING AND SIX O'CLOCK IN THE MORNING, WHENEVER THE OUTDOOR TEMPERATURE FALLS BELOW FORTY DEGREES FAHRENHEIT.
 - 2. NOTHING IN THIS SECTION SHALL RELIEVE AN OWNER OF THE DUTY TO PROVIDE CENTRALLY SUPPLIED OR OTHER APPROVED SOURCE OF HEAT IN A DWELL-ING, IN ANY CASE WHERE SUCH HEAT IS REQUIRED BY THIS CHAPTER OR ANY OTHER LAW, ORDINANCE, RULE, OR REGULATION. NOTHING IN THIS SECTION SHALL PROHIBIT A TENANT OR OTHER LEGAL OCCUPANT, AS SUCH TERMS ARE DEFINED IN SECTION TWO HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE-F OF THE REAL PROPERTY LAW, FROM INTENTIONALLY MAINTAINING A DWELLING TEMPERATURE LOWER THAN PRESCRIBED IN THIS SECTION.
- 27 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
