AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to requiring breathalyzer tests of drivers involved in accidents damaging other vehicles from behind

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 603 of the vehicle and traffic law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision 3 to read as follows:

3 3. IN ADDITION TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS SECTION, 4 EVERY POLICE OFFICER OR JUDICIAL OFFICER TO WHOM AN ACCIDENT SHALL HAVE 5 BEEN REPORTED INVOLVING A VEHICLE WHICH IS HIT FROM BEHIND BY ANOTHER б VEHICLE SHALL IMMEDIATELY INVESTIGATE THE FACTS, OR CAUSE THE SAME TO BE 7 то THECOMMISSIONER FORTHWITH, INVESTIGATED AND REPORT THEMATTER 8 PROVIDED THAT SUCH INVESTIGATION OF THE ACCIDENT SCENE SHALL ALSO INCLUDE THE ADMINISTRATION OF FIELD SOBRIETY 9 AND A CHEMICAL TEST OF BLOOD ALCOHOL LEVEL TO THE MOTOR VEHICLE DRIVER WHO HIT THE SECOND VEHI-10 CLE FROM BEHIND. THE INVESTIGATING POLICE OFFICERS MUST INFORM THE DRIV-11 OF SUCH TESTING REQUIREMENTS AND CONDUCT THEM IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE 12 ER 13 PROVISIONS OF SECTION ELEVEN HUNDRED NINETY-FOUR OF THIS CHAPTER. THE REFUSAL TO SUBMIT TO SUCH TESTING SHALL CONSTITUTE A REBUTTABLE PRESUMP-14 TION OF AND SUCH REFUSAL SHALL BE DOCUMENTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH 15 GUILT 16 THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION ELEVEN HUNDRED NINETY-FOUR OF THIS CHAPTER. IF 17 PHYSICAL INJURIES DO NOT PERMIT SUCH CHEMICAL TESTING AT THE ACCIDENT 18 SCENE, SUCH TESTS MUST BE ADMINISTERED AT THE HOSPITAL. THE RESULTS OF SUCH FIELD SOBRIETY AND CHEMICAL TESTS OR REFUSALS OF SUCH 19 TESTS SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE POLICE INVESTIGATION REPORT. THE POLICE SHALL FORWARD 20 A COPY OF THE INVESTIGATION REPORT TO THE COMMISSIONER WITHIN FIVE BUSI-21 22 NESS DAYS OF THE COMPLETION OF SUCH REPORT.

23 S 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall 24 have become a law.
