AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to requiring certain motor vehicle forms and applications to be available in Punjabi, Bengali and Hindi

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new  
2 section 207-a to read as follows:  
3 S 207-A. FORMS TO BE MADE AVAILABLE IN CERTAIN FOREIGN LANGUAGES. THE  
4 COMMISSIONER SHALL PROVIDE THAT ALL FORMS, TESTS AND APPLICATIONS FOR  
5 PERMITS AND DRIVER'S LICENSES, INCLUDING RENEWALS, IN A CITY WITH A  
6 POPULATION OF ONE MILLION OR MORE SHALL BE AVAILABLE IN PUNJABI, BENGALI  
7 AND HINDI, AND THAT TRANSLATION AND INTERPRETATION SERVICES IN SUCH  
8 LANGUAGES BE PROVIDED UPON REQUEST.  
9 S 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall  
10 have become a law.
