AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to directing the
council on children and families to establish an online listing and
map of publicly funded or registered afterschool and school age child
care programs

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-
BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 483-b of the social services law is amended by
2 adding a new subdivision 6 to read as follows:
3 6. (A) THE COUNCIL SHALL MAKE, DEVELOP AND MAKE AVAILABLE THROUGH A
4 LINK ON ITS WEBSITE:
5 (1) A LISTING OF: (A) ALL RECIPIENTS OF GRANTS AWARDED OR ADMINISTERED
6 BY THE STATE FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING AFTERSCHOOL OR SUMMER
7 PROGRAMS, EXTENDED LEARNING TIME, OR COMMUNITY SCHOOLS; AND (B) ALL
8 REGISTERED SCHOOL AGE CHILD CARE PROVIDERS REGISTERED BY THE OFFICE OF
9 CHILDREN AND FAMILY SERVICES; AND
10 (2) A MAP DISPLAYING THE LOCATIONS OF THE AWARD RECIPIENTS AND PROVID-
11 ERS DESCRIBED IN SUBPARAGRAPH ONE OF THIS PARAGRAPH.
12 (B) THE LISTING SHALL INCLUDE FOR EACH GRANT RECIPIENT OR PROVIDER THE
13 RECIPIENT'S OR PROVIDER'S NAME, THE ADDRESS AT WHICH THE PROGRAM IS
14 OFFERED, AND THE NAME AND PHONE NUMBER OF AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS AUTHOR-
15 IZED TO ANSWER QUESTIONS REGARDING THE PROGRAM.
16 (C) THE LISTING AND MAP SHALL BE UPDATED NO LESS THAN ONCE EVERY NINE-
17 TY DAYS TO REFLECT ANY CHANGES IN SCHOOL AGE CHILD CARE REGISTRATIONS.
18 THE LISTING AND MAP SHALL ALSO BE UPDATED WITHIN NINETY DAYS OF THE DATE
19 UPON WHICH ANY CONTRACT WITH A GRANT RECIPIENT IS SIGNED OR HAS EXPIRED.
20 (D) THE COUNCIL MAY INCLUDE LOCATIONS AND INFORMATION FOR ADDITIONAL
21 RELEVANT PROGRAMS AS IT SEES FIT.
22 S 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall
23 have become a law.
