AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to designating the Chateaugay lake as an inland waterway for purposes of waterfront revitalization

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 4 of section 911 of the executive law, as separately amended by chapters 133 and 147 of the laws of 3 2012, is amended to read as follows:
- 4 (a) the state's major inland lakes consisting of lakes Big Tupper, 5 Black, Canadarago, Canandaigua, Cayuga, Champlain, CHATEAUGAY, Chautau-6 qua, Conesus, Cranberry, George, Great Sacandaga, Honoeye, Indian, 7 Keuka, Long, Mirror, Oneida, Onondaga, Otisco, Otsego, Owasco, Placid, 8 Raquette, Ronkonkoma, Sacandaga, Saratoga, Schroon, Seneca, Skaneateles, 9 Silver (in the county of Wyoming) and Saranac, and the Fulton chain of lakes;
- 11 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
