AN ACT to amend the real property tax law, in relation to the base proportion in approved assessing units in Nassau county

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 3 of section 1903 of the real property tax law is amended by adding a new subparagraph (xv) to read as 3 follows:

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(XV) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, IN AN APPROVED ASSESSING UNIT IN THE COUNTY OF NASSAU AND FOR CURRENT BASE PROPORTIONS DETERMINED BY TAXES BASED ON SUCH APPROVED ASSESSING UNIT'S TWO 7 THOUSAND FOURTEEN ROLL, THE CURRENT BASE PROPORTION OF ANY CLASS NOT EXCEED THE ADJUSTED BASE PROPORTION OR ADJUSTED PROPORTION, WHICHEV-9 APPROPRIATE, OF THE IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING YEAR, BY MORE THAN ONE 10 PERCENT, PROVIDED THAT SUCH APPROVED ASSESSING UNIT HAS PASSED 11 ORDINANCE OR RESOLUTION PROVIDING THEREFOR. WHERE THE COMPUTATION OF CURRENT BASE PROPORTIONS WOULD OTHERWISE PRODUCE 12 SUCH RESULT, CURRENT BASE PROPORTION OF SUCH CLASS OR CLASSES SHALL BE LIMITED TO 13 14 SUCH ONE PERCENT INCREASE AND THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF SUCH APPROVED ASSESSING UNIT SHALL ALTER THE CURRENT BASE PROPORTION OF EITHER CLASS 15 SO THAT THE SUM OF THE CURRENT BASE PROPORTIONS EQUALS ONE. 16

S 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall apply to the 17 levy of taxes based on the 2014 assessment roll in approved assessing 18 19 units in the county of Nassau that pass a local law, ordinance or resol-20 ution to adopt these provisions.
