AN ACT to amend the labor law, in relation to discrimination based on an individual's or a dependent's reproductive health decision making

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The labor law is amended by adding a new section 203-e to 2 read as follows:
- 3 203-E. PROHIBITION OF DISCRIMINATION BASED ON AN INDIVIDUAL'S OR A DEPENDENT'S REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH DECISION MAKING. 1. ANEMPLOYER NOT DISCRIMINATE AGAINST AN INDIVIDUAL WITH RESPECT TO COMPENSATION, TERMS, CONDITIONS, OR PRIVILEGES OF EMPLOYMENT 6 BECAUSE OF OR ON 7 BASIS OF THE INDIVIDUAL'S OR A DEPENDENT'S REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH DECISION MAKING, INCLUDING A DECISION TO USE OR ACCESS A PARTICULAR DRUG, 9 OR MEDICAL SERVICE, OR BECAUSE OF OR ON THE BASIS OF AN EMPLOYER'S
- 10 PERSONAL BELIEFS ABOUT SUCH SERVICES.
- 2. NOTHING IN THIS SECTION SHALL BE CONSTRUED TO LIMIT ANY RIGHTS OF AN EMPLOYEE PROVIDED THROUGH ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW OR COLLECTIVE
- 13 BARGAINING UNIT.
- 14 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
