AN ACT to amend the civil service law and the correction law, in relation to compensation and other terms and conditions of employment of certain state officers and employees and to repeal certain provisions of such laws relating thereto

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Legislative intent. This act enacts into law legislation
 2 necessary to implement changes to salary and benefits for certain state
 3 officers and employees excluded from collective negotiating units.
 4 S 2. Paragraph d of subdivision 1 of section 130 of the civil service
 5 law is REPEALED and a new paragraph d is added to read as follows:
 6 D. SALARY GRADES FOR POSITIONS IN THE COMPETITIVE, NON-COMPETITIVE AND
 7 LABOR CLASSES OF THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK DESIGNATED
 8 MANAGERIAL OR CONFIDENTIAL PURSUANT TO ARTICLE FOURTEEN OF THIS
 9 CHAPTER, SHALL BE AS FOLLOWS ON THE EFFECTIVE DATES INDICATED:
 10 SALARIES AND BENEFITS FOR CERTAIN STATE
 11 OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES EXCLUDED FROM
 12 COLLECTIVE NEGOTIATING UNITS FOR 2014-2016

53 S 3. Subdivision 1 of section 19 of the correction law is REPEALED and a
54 new subdivision 1 is added to read as follows:

1 1. THIS SECTION SHALL APPLY TO EACH SUPERINTENDENT OF A CORRECTIONAL
2 FACILITY APPOINTED ON OR AFTER AUGUST NINTH, NINETEEN HUNDRED
3 SEVENTY-FIVE AND ANY SUPERINTENDENT HERETOFORE APPOINTED WHO ELECTS TO
4 BE COVERED BY THE PROVISIONS THEREOF BY FILING SUCH ELECTION WITH THE
5 COMMISSIONER.
