AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to authorizing hunting in the county of Livingston; and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon expiration thereof

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. Paragraph a of subdivision 2 of section 11-0907 of the  
2 environmental conservation law is amended by adding a new item (m) to
