AN ACT to amend the agriculture and markets law, in relation to the prohibition of animal fighting

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Subdivision 4 of section 351 of the agriculture and markets law, as added by chapter 150 of the laws of 1984, is amended to read as follows:
- 4 4. (a) Any person who engages in conduct specified in paragraph (b) OR (C) hereof is guilty of a misdemeanor and is punishable by imprisonment for a period not to exceed one year, or by a fine not to exceed one thousand dollars, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
- 8 (b) The knowing presence as a spectator having paid an admission fee 9 or having made a wager at any place where an exhibition of animal fight-10 ing is being conducted; OR
- 11 (C) KNOWINGLY CAUSES A MINOR TO ATTEND AN EXHIBITION OF ANIMAL FIGHT-12 ING. THE TERM "MINOR" MEANS A PERSON UNDER THE AGE OF SIXTEEN YEARS 13 OLD.
- 14 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
