AN ACT to amend the criminal procedure law, in relation to oral applications for a search warrant

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 690.36 of the criminal procedure 2 law, as added by chapter 679 of the laws of 1982, is amended to read as 3 follows:
- Where an oral application for a search warrant is made, the applicant therefor must identify himself OR HERSELF and the purpose of his OR 5 HER communication. After being sworn as provided in subdivision three of 6 7 this section, the applicant must also make the statement required by paragraph (b) of subdivision [two] THREE of section 690.35 OF THIS ARTI-CLE and provide the same allegations of fact required by paragraph (c) 9 10 of such subdivision; provided, however, persons, properly identified, other than the applicant may also provide some or all of such allega-11 tions of fact directly to the court. Where appropriate, the applicant 12 may also make a request specified in subdivision [three] FOUR of section 13 14 690.35 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- 15 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
