AN ACT to amend the uniform city court act, in relation to authorizing evening court hours in cities with a population of two hundred fifty thousand or less

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The uniform city court act is amended by adding a new 2 section 2105 to read as follows:
- 3 S 2105. HOLDING OF COURT.
- 4 NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, RULE OR REGULATION TO THE 5 CONTRARY, A CITY WITH A POPULATION OF TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND OR LESS 6 MAY EXTEND THE HOURS DURING WHICH THE CITY CONDUCTS COURT PROCEEDINGS TO INCLUDE EVENINGS FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSIDERING MATTERS THAT ARE NEITHER
- 8 CHARGED AS MISDEMEANORS NOR FELONIES.
- 9 S 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 10 have become a law.
