AN ACT to amend the town law, in relation to providing for the election of a third town justice in the town of Wallkill in the county of Orange

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 20 of the town law is amended by adding a new paragraph (p) to read as follows:
- (P) NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF ANY GENERAL, SPECIAL OR TO THE CONTRARY, THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF WALLKILL, COUNTY OF ORANGE MAY ADOPT A RESOLUTION, SUBJECT TO A PERMISSIVE REFERENDUM AS 5 PROVIDED BY ARTICLE SEVEN OF THIS CHAPTER, AT LEAST SIXTY DAYS PRIOR TO ANY REGULAR OR SPECIAL ELECTION DETERMINING THAT SUCH TOWN SHALL 8 JUSTICES. IF THE TOWN BOARD OF SUCH TOWN SHALL HAVE ADOPTED THREE TOWN 9 SUCH A RESOLUTION AND NO PETITION SHALL HAVE BEEN FILED WITHIN THE 10 SPECIFIED FOR A REFERENDUM THEREON, OR IF A MAJORITY OF THE VOTES CAST ON ANY SUCH PROPOSITION SUBMITTED TO THE VOTE OF THE ELECTORS BE IN 11 AFFIRMATIVE, THE ELECTORS OF SUCH TOWN SHALL ELECT AT THE SUCCEEDING 12 13 GENERAL ELECTION A TOWN JUSTICE WHO SHALL TAKE OFFICE FOR A TERM OF FOUR
- 13 GENERAL ELECTION A TOWN JUSTICE WHO SHALL TAKE OFFICE FOR A TERM OF FOUR 14 YEARS BEGINNING ON THE FIRST DAY OF JANUARY NEXT SUCCEEDING SUCH BIENNI-
- 15 AL TOWN ELECTION.
- 16 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
