AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system as the "Sergeant Major Daniel Joseph Daly Memorial Highway"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 344-c to 2 read as follows:
 - S 344-C. PORTION OF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM TO BE DESIGNATED AS THE "SERGEANT MAJOR DANIEL JOSEPH DALY MEMORIAL HIGHWAY". THAT PORTION OF NEW YORK STATE ROUTE ONE HUNDRED SEVEN IN THE CITY OF GLEN COVE BEGINNING FROM THE SOUTHERN CITY LINE TO PULASKI STREET, SHALL BE DESIGNATED AND KNOWN AS "SERGEANT MAJOR DANIEL JOSEPH DALY MEMORIAL HIGHWAY".
- 8 S 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the instal-9 lation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system 10 as designated pursuant to section one of this act. However, to avoid 11 confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the desig-12 nation called for pursuant to this act shall be one of a ceremonial 13 nature and the official name of such highway shall not be changed as a 14 result of this act.
- 15 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
