AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to the establishment of a  
human trafficking hotline

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY,  
DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. The executive law is amended by adding a new section 75 to  
2     read as follows:  
3     S 75. HUMAN TRAFFICKING HOTLINE. 1. THE ATTORNEY GENERAL SHALL ESTAB-  
4     LISH AND MAINTAIN A TWENTY-FOUR HOUR TOLL-FREE STATEWIDE HOTLINE NUMBER  
5     FOR USE IN THE INVESTIGATION AND PREVENTION OF HUMAN TRAFFICKING.  
6     2. CALLS MADE TO THE TOLL-FREE STATEWIDE HOTLINE SHALL BE ANONYMOUS.  
7     3. THE ATTORNEY GENERAL SHALL REFER INFORMATION OBTAINED THROUGH THE  
8     STATEWIDE HOTLINE TO THE APPROPRIATE DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE WITH  
9     JURISDICTION IN THE MATTER.  
10    S 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after  
11    it shall have become a law. Effective immediately, the addition, amend-  
12    ment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation necessary for the implemen-  
13    tation of this act on its effective date is authorized to be made and  
14    completed on or before such effective date.
