WHEREAS, The 2013 William Smith College Women's Soccer Team finished the season with a record of 23-1; it was the 480th career win for William Smith Soccer Head Coach Aliceann Wilber, the winningest coach in NCAA Division III Women's Soccer; and

WHEREAS, The athletic talent displayed by the 2013 William Smith College Women's Soccer Team is due in great part to the efforts of Head Coach Aliceann Wilber, a skilled and inspirational tutor, respected for her ability to develop potential into excellence; Coach Wilber and her Assistant Coaches, Chas Allen, Keith Perrigo, Dave Karweck, BreLynn Nasypany, and Chris Teerlinck have done a superb job in guiding, molding and inspiring the 2013 William Smith College Women's Soccer Team members toward their goals; and

WHEREAS, The hallmarks of the 2013 William Smith College Women's Soccer Team, from the opening game of the season to its NCAA Division III National Championship, were a sisterhood of athletic ability, of good sportsmanship, of honor and of scholarship, demonstrating that these team players are second to none; and
