WHEREAS, Under the luminous direction of school Librarian Kathleen Jaccarino, the Brockport High School Library is truly a place to learn and grow, and hosts numerous opportunities to get both teacher and student groups together for reading activities; and

WHEREAS, Furthermore, Kathleen Jaccarino, and library staff, Jane Agte and Pauline Pratt, are knowledgeable, enthusiastic, creative and accommodating; these remarkable women take on much more than their job descriptions entail, cultivating relationships with faculty and students alike, working on the school culture and the attitudes students have toward reading; and

WHEREAS, It is the sense of this Legislative Body that when institutions of such noble aims and accomplishments are brought to our attention, they should be recognized and applauded by all the citizens of this great Empire State; now, therefore, be it
