AN ACT to amend part R2 of chapter 62 of the laws of 2003, amending the mental hygiene law and the state finance law relating to the community mental health support and workforce reinvestment program and the membership of subcommittees for mental health of community service boards and the duties of such subcommittees and creating the community health and workforce reinvestment account, in relation to the effective date thereof

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. Section 7 of part R2 of chapter 62 of the laws of 2003,  
2     amending the mental hygiene law and the state finance law relating to  
3     the community mental health support and workforce reinvestment program  
4     and the membership of subcommittees for mental health of community  
5     service boards and the duties of such subcommittees and creating the  
6     community mental health and workforce reinvestment account, as amended  
7     by section 3 of part H of chapter 56 of the laws of 2013, is amended to  
8     read as follows:  
9     S 7. This act shall take effect immediately and shall expire March 31,  
10    2015 when upon such date the provisions of this act shall be deemed  
11    repealed; PROVIDED FURTHER, THAT SECTIONS TWO AND SIX OF THIS ACT SHALL  
12    EXPIRE MARCH 31, 2020 WHEN UPON SUCH DATE THE PROVISIONS OF SUCH  
13    SECTIONS SHALL BE DEEMED REPEALED.  
14    S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
