AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to authorizing residents of the counties of St. Lawrence, Jefferson and Oswego to collect downed lumber from state owned forest lands outside the forest preserve; and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon the expiration thereof

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 3-0301 of the environmental conservation law is amended by adding a new paragraph dd to read as follows:
  - DD. NOTWITHSTANDING SECTION 9-0505 OF THIS CHAPTER, THE COMMISSIONER SHALL, BY REGULATION, CREATE AND IMPLEMENT A PROGRAM THAT WILL ALLOW RESIDENTS OF THE COUNTIES OF ST. LAWRENCE, JEFFERSON, AND OSWEGO TO COLLECT DOWNED LUMBER FROM STATE OWNED FOREST LANDS OUTSIDE THE FOREST PRESERVE.
- 9 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeed10 ing the date on which it shall have become law and shall expire 3 years
  11 after such effective date when upon such date the provisions of this act
  12 shall be deemed repealed. Effective immediately, the addition, amendment
  13 and/or repeal of any rules or regulations necessary for the implementa14 tion of this act on its effective date are authorized to be made on or
  15 before such date.
