AN ACT to amend the criminal procedure law, in relation to requiring the court, prior to accepting a plea to a misdemeanor or violation, to advise the defendant of the risk of deportation if he or she is not a citizen

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 340.20 of the criminal procedure law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision 5 to read as follows:

3 5. PRIOR TO ACCEPTING A DEFENDANT'S PLEA OF GUILTY TO A COUNT OR 4 AN INFORMATION, AS DEFINED BY SUBDIVISION ONE OF SECTION COUNTS OF 5 340.10 OF THIS ARTICLE, CHARGING A MISDEMEANOR, AS DEFINED IN SUBDIVI-SION TWO OF SECTION 55.10 OF THE PENAL LAW, OR A VIOLATION, AS DEFINED 6 7 BY SUBDIVISION THREE OF SECTION 55.10 OF THE PENAL LAW, THE COURT SHALL 8 ADVISE DEFENDANT THAT IF THE DEFENDANT IS NOT A CITIZEN OF THE THE 9 UNITED STATES, THE DEFENDANT'S PLEA OF GUILTY AND THE COURT'S ACCEPTANCE 10 THEREOF MAY RESULT IN THE DEFENDANT'S DEPORTATION OR REMOVAL, EXCLUSION FROM ADMISSION TO THE UNITED STATES OR DENIAL OF NATURALIZATION PURSUANT 11 TO THE LAWS OF THE UNITED STATES. IN ADDITION, THE COURT SHALL, PRIOR TO 12 13 ACCEPTING SUCH PLEA, ADVISE THE DEFENDANT THAT, IF THE DEFENDANT IS NOT A CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES AND IS OR BECOMES THE SUBJECT OF A 14 FINAL 15 ORDER OF REMOVAL ISSUED BY THE UNITED STATES IMMIGRATION AND CUSTOMS ENFORCEMENT, THE DEFENDANT MAY BE RELEASED TO THE CUSTODY OF 16 THEIMMI-GRATION AND CUSTOMS ENFORCEMENT FOR REMOVAL PURPOSES AS A RESULT OF THE 17 THE FAILURE TO ADVISE THE DEFENDANT DEFENDANT'S PLEA OF GUILTY. 18 PURSU-19 TO THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL NOT BE DEEMED TO AFFECT THE VOLUNTARINESS ANT 20 OF A PLEA OF GUILTY OF THE VALIDITY OF A CONVICTION, NOR SHALL IT AFFORD A DEFENDANT ANY RIGHTS IN SUBSEQUENT PROCEEDING RELATING TO SUCH DEFEND-21 THE COURT 22 ANT'S DEPORTATION, EXCLUSION OR DENIAL OR NATURALIZATION.
