AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to establishing the class B felony of criminal sale of a controlled substance by a practitioner or pharmacist

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 220.66 to read as follows:

13 14 S 220.66 CRIMINAL SALE OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE BY A PRACTITIONER OR PHARMACIST.

A PERSON IS GUILTY OF CRIMINAL SALE OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE BY A PRACTITIONER OR PHARMACIST WHEN, BEING A PRACTITIONER OR PHARMACIST, AS THOSE TERMS ARE DEFINED IN SECTION THIRTY-THREE HUNDRED TWO OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH LAW, OR A PHARMACY INTERN ACTING IN CONFORMITY WITH THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION SIXTY-EIGHT HUNDRED SIX OF THE EDUCATION LAW AND ANY REGULATIONS ADOPTED PURSUANT THERETO IN A REGISTERED PHARMACY, HE OR SHE KNOWINGLY AND UNLAWFULLY SELLS A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, A PERSON SELLS A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE UNLAWFULLY WHEN HE OR SHE DOES SO OTHER THAN IN GOOD FAITH IN THE COURSE OF HIS OR HER PROFESSIONAL PRACTICE.

15 CRIMINAL SALE OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE BY A PRACTITIONER OR PHARMA-16 CIST IS A CLASS B FELONY.

17 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeed-18 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
