AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to the creation of an animal cruelty and animal fighting database

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Legislative findings. Studies in psychology, sociology 1 and 2 criminology have demonstrated that violent offenders frequently have 3 childhood and adolescent histories of serious and repeated animal cruel-4 ty. The Federal Bureau of Investigation has recognized this connection 5 the 1970s when its analysis of the lives of serial killers since 6 suggested that most had killed or tortured animals during their life. Other research has shown consistent patterns of animal cruelty among 7 perpetrators of more common forms of violence, including child abuse, 8 9 spouse abuse, and elder abuse, leading the American Psychiatric Association to consider animal cruelty as one of the diagnostic criteria of 10 conduct disorder. 11

12 S 2. The executive law is amended by adding a new section 837-s to 13 read as follows:

14 S 837-S. ANIMAL CRUELTY DATABASE. THE DIVISION SHALL ESTABLISH AND 15 MAINTAIN A CRIME DATABASE ON ALL CRIMES OF ANIMAL CRUELTY AND ANIMAL SHALL BE 16 FIGHTING COMMITTED IN THE STATE WHERE DATA OF SUCH CRIMES 17 COLLECTED AND DISPLAYED IN A MANNER THAT FACILITATES ANALYSIS. SUCH CRIME DATABASE SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, NAMES OF PERSONS 18 19 CONVICTED OF ANIMAL CRUELTY AND ANIMAL FIGHTING AS SET FORTH IN ARTICLE 20 TWENTY-SIX OF THE AGRICULTURE AND MARKETS LAW AND THE SPECIFIC ACTS OF ANIMAL CRUELTY OR ANIMAL FIGHTING THAT WERE THE BASIS OF THE CONVICTION. 21 22 PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, SUCH DATABASE SHALL ALSO INCLUDE FOR THE 23 INFORMATION ON PERSONS WHO HAVE PLED GUILTY TO A CHARGE OTHER THAN 24 ANIMAL CRUELTY OR ANIMAL FIGHTING IN SATISFACTION OF THE ANIMAL CRUELTY 25 OR ANIMAL FIGHTING CHARGE OR WHERE ANIMAL CRUELTY OR THE ANIMAL FIGHTING
