AN ACT to amend the racing, pari-mutuel wagering and breeding law, in relation to antitrust exemptions for horse racing agreements

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 The racing, pari-mutuel wagering and breeding law is 2 amended by adding a new section 113-a to read as follows:

3 S 113-A. ANTITRUST EXEMPTIONS. STATE AND FEDERAL ANTITRUST LAWS NOT APPLY TO ANY JOINT AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO, IN CONSULTATION WITH AND JOINTLY APPROVED BY THE STATE GAMING COMMISSION AND THE ATTORNEY AL, BY OR AMONG NON-PROFIT RACING ASSOCIATIONS, THOROUGHBRED RACING 6 7 ASSOCIATIONS OR CORPORATIONS, HARNESS RACING ASSOCIATIONS RATIONS, OUARTER HORSE RACING ASSOCIATIONS OR CORPORATIONS, AND REGIONAL 8 OFF-TRACK BETTING CORPORATIONS TO COORDINATE THE DATES AND TIMES UNDER 9 WHICH THEY WILL CONDUCT PROGRAMS OF RACING AND OFFER PARI-MUTUEL WAGER-10 IN ADDITION, SUCH ANTITRUST LAWS SHALL NOT APPLY TO JOINT AGREE-11 MENTS ENTERED INTO, IN CONSULTATION WITH AND JOINTLY APPROVED 12 13 STATE GAMING COMMISSION AND THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, BY OR AMONG NON-PROFIT 14 RACING ASSOCIATIONS, THOROUGHBRED RACING ASSOCIATIONS OR CORPORATIONS, HARNESS RACING ASSOCIATIONS OR CORPORATIONS, QUARTER HORSE RACING ASSO-15 16 CIATIONS OR CORPORATIONS, AND REGIONAL OFF-TRACK BETTING CORPORATIONS TO 17 SELL, TRANSFER, ASSIGN OR PURCHASE THE RIGHTS TO BROADCAST, SIMULCAST, 18 ELECTRONICALLY TRANSMIT OR OFFER PARI-MUTUEL WAGERING ON HORSE 19 STATE GAMING COMMISSION AND THE ATTORNEY GENERAL SHALL JOINTLY

CONSIDER AND APPROVE SUCH AGREEMENTS AND THE TERMS 20 THEREIN TO FURTHER

STATE'S INTEREST IN ENSURING THE VIABILITY AND CONTINUED EXISTENCE 21

IN THIS STATE OF THE HORSE RACING AND AGRICULTURE INDUSTRIES. 22

23 S 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after 24 it shall have become a law.
