AN ACT to amend the agriculture and markets law, in relation to establishing and implementing training programs for dog control officers

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The agriculture and markets law is amended by adding a new 1 2 section 113-a to read as follows:

- S 113-A. TRAINING PROGRAM FOR DOG CONTROL OFFICERS. 1. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ESTABLISH AND IMPLEMENT A TRAINING PROGRAM FOR DOG CONTROL OFFI-CERS.
- 2. (A) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (B) OR (C) OF THIS SUBDIVISION, ANY PERSON APPOINTED BY A LOCAL GOVERNMENT AS A DOG CONTROL OFFICER A COURSE OF TRAINING APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT. ANY SHALL COMPLETE PERSON EMPLOYED ON THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION AS A DOG 10 OFFICER SHALL COMPLETE THE FIRST SUCH TRAINING PROGRAM NO LATER THAN JANUARY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND FIFTEEN. 11 ANY PERSON APPOINTED AFTER DATE OF THIS SECTION SHALL COMPLETE SUCH TRAINING BY JANUARY 12 EFFECTIVE 13 FIRST, TWO THOUSAND FIFTEEN OR WITHIN ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY DAYS APPOINTMENT WHICHEVER IS LATER. DOCUMENTATION THATSUCH PERSON HAS 15 COMPLETED SUCH TRAINING SHALL BE MAINTAINED BY THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT BE MADE AVAILABLE TO THE DEPARTMENT UPON REQUEST.
- Α 17 (B) VETERINARIAN LICENSED PURSUANT TO ARTICLE ONE HUNDRED 18 THIRTY-FIVE OF THE EDUCATION LAW SHALL BE EXEMPT FROM THE TRAINING 19 PROGRAM REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION.
- 20 (C) A LOCAL GOVERNMENT THAT EMPLOYS A DOG CONTROL OFFICER MAY ELECT 21 NOT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE TRAINING PROGRAM REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION IF

SUCH LOCAL GOVERNMENT HAS A TRAINING PROGRAM FOR DOG CONTROL OFFICERS THAT MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS SET FORTH IN SUBDIVISION THREE OF SECTION, AND IS APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT. THE GOVERNING BODY OF A LOCAL GOVERNMENT THAT ELECTS TO CONDUCT ITS OWN DOG CONTROL OFFICER 5 PROGRAM MUST DO SO BY ADOPTING A RESOLUTION DECLARING THAT 6 CONDUCT ITS OWN TRAINING PROGRAM AND PROVIDING SUCH RESOLUTION TO THE 7 DEPARTMENT.

- 3. THE TRAINING PROGRAM REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION SHALL INCLUDE TRAIN-ING REGARDING:
 - (A) THE SCOPE OF THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE DOG CONTROL OFFICER;
- (B) APPROPRIATE AND HUMANE HANDLING OF ANIMALS, INCLUDING TRANSPORTING 12 SAFELY, GENERAL ANIMAL CONTROL AND PROPER METHODS FOR CAPTURING ANIMALS ANIMALS;
 - (C) THE LAWS AND RULES REGARDING DOG LICENSING, SEARCH AND SEIZURE RELEVANT TO DOG CONTROL OFFICERS;
 - (D) PROPER DISPOSAL OF THE REMAINS OF DECEASED ANIMALS;
 - (E) IDENTIFICATION AND NOTIFICATION OF AN ANIMAL'S OWNER; AND
 - (F) OTHER SUBJECT MATTER RELEVANT TO DOG CONTROL OFFICERS AS DEEMED NECESSARY OR APPROPRIATE BY THE COMMISSIONER.
 - 4. GOVERNING BODIES OF LOCAL GOVERNMENTS SHALL TERMINATE THE APPOINT-MENT OF ANY DOG CONTROL OFFICER WHO FAILS TO COMPLETE THE TRAINING PROGRAM REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION.
 - 5. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL, IN CONSULTATION WITH INDIVIDUALS AND ORGAN-INVOLVED WITH ANIMAL CARE AND CONTROL THAT THE COMMISSIONER DEEMS APPROPRIATE, IDENTIFY AND APPROVE AT LEAST ONE TRAINING PROGRAM FOR DOG CONTROL OFFICERS TO MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBDIVISIONS TWO AND THREE OF THIS SECTION THAT IS BOTH COST-EFFECTIVE AND ACCESSIBLE. DEPARTMENT SHALL MAKE INFORMATION ABOUT SUCH PROGRAM AVAILABLE UPON ITS INTERNET WEBSITE. SUCH PROGRAM MAY BE PROVIDED IN AN INTERNET-BASED FORMAT. IF THE DEPARTMENT DOES NOT APPROVE AN INTERNET-BASED FORMAT, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ENSURE THAT THE TRAINING PROGRAM IS AVAILABLE IN VARI-OUS REGIONS OF THE STATE IN ORDER TO ENSURE REASONABLE ACCESSIBILITY FOR DOG CONTROL OFFICERS.
 - 6. THE DEPARTMENT IS AUTHORIZED TO PROMULGATE RULES, REGULATIONS AND STANDARDS FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF THE TRAINING PROGRAM, INCLUDING RULES FOR COMPLIANCE BY DOG CONTROL OFFICERS AND THE FREQUENCY WITH WHICH SUCH OFFICERS SHALL BE REQUIRED TO COMPLETE THE TRAINING PROGRAM.
 - 7. THE COMMISSIONER MAY SOLICIT AND ACCEPT FUNDS FROM ANY PUBLIC OR PRIVATE SOURCE TO HELP CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.
- S 2. This act shall take effect immediately; provided that the addi-40 tion, amendment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation necessary for 41 the implementation of this act on its effective date takes place within 42 43 eighteen months of the effective date.
