AN ACT to amend the insurance law, in relation to insurance coverage for out-of-network flu shots

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subsection (i) of section 3216 of the insurance law is
2 amended by adding a new paragraph 30 to read as follows:
3 (30) EVERY POLICY THAT INCLUDES COVERAGE FOR A FLU SHOT THAT REQUIRES
4 SUCH SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED BY AN IN-NETWORK PROVIDER SHALL NOT DENY
5 COVERAGE FOR AN INDIVIDUAL WHO RECEIVES THE FLU SHOT FROM AN OUT-OF-NET-
6 WORK PROVIDER.
7 S 2. Subsection (k) of section 3221 of the insurance law is amended by
8 adding a new paragraph 19 to read as follows:
9 (19) EVERY POLICY THAT INCLUDES COVERAGE FOR A FLU SHOT THAT REQUIRES
10 SUCH SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED BY AN IN-NETWORK PROVIDER SHALL NOT DENY
11 COVERAGE FOR AN INDIVIDUAL WHO RECEIVES THE FLU SHOT FROM AN OUT-OF-NET-
12 WORK PROVIDER.
13 S 3. Section 4303 of the insurance law is amended by adding a new
14 subsection (jj) to read as follows:
15 (JJ) EVERY POLICY THAT INCLUDES COVERAGE FOR A FLU SHOT THAT REQUIRES
16 SUCH SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED BY AN IN-NETWORK PROVIDER SHALL NOT DENY
17 COVERAGE FOR AN INDIVIDUAL WHO RECEIVES THE FLU SHOT FROM AN OUT-OF-NET-
18 WORK PROVIDER.
19 S 4. Subsection (b) of section 4322 of the insurance law is amended by
20 adding a new paragraph 28 to read as follows:
21 (28) FLU SHOTS.
22 S 5. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeed-
23 ing the date on which it shall have become a law and shall apply to
24 insurance policies and contracts issued, renewed, modified or altered on
25 or after such effective date.
