AN ACT in relation to directing the commissioner of health to conduct a study of certain health care delivery models and to deliver a report of the study's results to the governor, the speaker of the assembly, the minority leader of the assembly, the temporary president of the senate and the minority leader of the senate

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "health care delivery models study act".

The commissioner of health is directed to conduct a study of current innovations in the delivery of health care services not presently required to undergo state certificate of need processes nor required to obtain authorization to conduct office based surgery. Entities to be studied shall include, but not be limited to, clinics operating within pharmacies (mini-clinics), medical offices open for extended hours without an appointment (urgent care centers), and major physician practices (whether in one location or multiple locations) whose physicians are linked directly or indirectly in an economic relationship.

12 The study shall examine the impact or impacts of the respective enti-13 ties on the delivery, quality and cost of health care in the respective 14 communities and regions in which they are found.

The commissioner of health shall report, publish and transmit his or her findings to the governor, the speaker of the assembly, the minority leader of the assembly, the temporary president of the senate and the minority leader of the senate on or before one year from the date this act shall take effect.

S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
