AN ACT to amend the public service law, in relation to remote net metering

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1     Section 1. Subdivision 3 of section 66-j of the public service law is  
2 amended by adding a new paragraph (g) to read as follows:  
3     (G) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY LAW, RULE, REGULATION OR POLICY TO THE CONTRA-  
4 RY, ELECTRIC CORPORATIONS ARE PROHIBITED FROM PLACING ANY RESTRICTION  
5 BASED UPON A MINIMUM LOAD REQUIREMENT FOR A HOST ACCOUNT, ON ANY CUSTOM-  
6 ER GENERATOR WHO OTHERWISE MEETS THE CRITERIA TO CONDUCT NET METERING IN  
7 ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF PARAGRAPH (F) OF THIS SUBDIVISION. A  
8 HOST ACCOUNT SHALL BE DEFINED AS THE SITE WHERE THE ELIGIBLE GENERATOR  
9 IS INTERCONNECTED WITH THE DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM.
- 10    S 2. Subdivision 3 of section 66-l of the public service law is  
11 amended by adding a new paragraph (f) to read as follows:  
12     (F) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY LAW, RULE, REGULATION OR POLICY TO THE CONTRA-  
13 RY, ELECTRIC CORPORATIONS ARE PROHIBITED FROM PLACING ANY RESTRICTION  
14 BASED UPON A MINIMUM LOAD REQUIREMENT FOR A HOST ACCOUNT, ON ANY CUSTOM-  
15 ER GENERATOR WHO OTHERWISE MEETS THE CRITERIA TO CONDUCT NET METERING IN  
16 ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF PARAGRAPH (E) OF THIS SUBDIVISION. A  
17 HOST ACCOUNT SHALL BE DEFINED AS THE SITE WHERE THE ELIGIBLE GENERATOR  
18 IS INTERCONNECTED WITH THE DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM.
- 19    S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
