AN ACT to amend the agriculture and markets law, in relation to conduct constituting aggravated cruelty to animals

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 353-a of the agriculture and 2 markets law, as added by chapter 118 of the laws of 1999, is amended to 3 read as follows:
 - 1. A person is guilty of aggravated cruelty to animals when, with no justifiable purpose, he or she intentionally kills or intentionally causes serious physical injury to a companion animal with aggravated cruelty. For purposes of this section, "aggravated cruelty" shall mean conduct which: (i) is intended to cause extreme physical pain; [or] (ii) is done or carried out in an especially depraved or sadistic manner; OR (III) OCCURS DURING THE COMMISSION OF A FELONY.
- 11 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
