AN ACT to authorize the assessor of the county of Nassau to accept an application for exemption from real property tax for the Locust Valley water district for a certain parcel of land located in the Oyster Bay

PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the assessor of the county of Nassau is hereby authorized to accept from the Locust Valley water district an application for exemption from real property taxes pursuant to section 410-a of the real property tax law for a portion of the 2010-2011 general taxes, the 2011-2012 school general taxes, the 2012-2013 school and general taxes and the 2010-2012 village taxes, for the parcel located in the town of Oyster Bay at 49 Horse Hollow Road, Lattingtown, otherwise known as: section 30, block B, lot 1269.

Ιf accepted, the application shall be reviewed as if it had been received on or before the taxable status date established for such roll. If satisfied that such organization would otherwise be entitled to 13 such exemption if such organization had filed an application for exemption by the appropriate taxable status date, the 14 assessor, 15 approval of the Nassau county legislature, may grant exemption from all taxation and make appropriate corrections to the subject roll. If such 16 exemption is granted and such organization therefore shall have paid any 17 tax with respect to the subject roll, the governing body or tax depart-18
