AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to authorizing hospice residences to care for up to 16 patients

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 2-b of section 4002 of the public health law, as amended by chapter 154 of the laws of 2004, is amended to read as follows:

- 2-b. "Hospice residence" means a hospice operated home which is residential in character and physical structure and operated for the purpose of providing more than two hospice patients but not more than [eight] SIXTEEN hospice patients with hospice care, which may include UP TO FOUR dually certified hospice in-patient beds PER EACH SIXTEEN BED RESIDENCE.
- S 2. Subdivision 1 of section 4014 of the public health law, as amended by chapter 410 of the laws of 2007, is amended to read as follows:
- 1. The commissioner is hereby authorized to establish a hospice residence pilot program. Such program, subject to the rules and regulations of the commissioner, shall authorize the operation of not more than ten hospice residences operated for the purpose of providing[, notwithstanding the provisions of subdivision two-b of section four thousand two of this article,] more than two hospice patients but not more than sixteen hospice patients with hospice care AS DEFINED BY SUBDIVISION TWO-B OF SECTION FOUR THOUSAND TWO OF THIS ARTICLE. The locations of the hospice residence pilot program shall be geographically disbursed throughout the state and approved by the commissioner. To the extent that patients may access hospital or skilled nursing home care, the care plan for such patients shall provide for such care.
- S 3. This act shall take effect immediately; provided, that the amendments to sections 4002 and 4014 of the public health law made by sections one and two of this act shall apply to hospice residences established prior to the effective date of this act as well as those created thereafter.
