AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system in the hamlet of West Babylon, county of Suffolk, as the "New York Police Department Detective Peter Figoski Memorial Bridge"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 343-aa 2 to read as follows:
  - S 343-AA. PORTION OF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM TO BE DESIGNATED AS "NEW YORK POLICE DEPARTMENT DETECTIVE PETER FIGOSKI MEMORIAL BRIDGE". THE BRIDGE ON ROUTE 109 WHICH CROSSES THE SUNRISE HIGHWAY IN THE HAMLET OF WEST BABYLON, COUNTY OF SUFFOLK, SHALL BE DESIGNATED AS THE "NEW YORK POLICE DEPARTMENT DETECTIVE PETER FIGOSKI MEMORIAL BRIDGE".
- 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the installation and maintenance of adequate signage of the state highway system designated pursuant to section one of this act; provided that, to 10 avoid any confusion and to limit any possible disruption of 11 the designations called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be of ceremonial nature and the official name of such highway and bridge 12
- 13 shall not be changed as a result of this act. 14
- 15 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
