- ACT to amend the labor law, in relation to retaliatory action by AN employers

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 740 of the labor law, as added by 1 2 chapter 660 of the laws of 1984, paragraph (a) as amended by chapter 442 3 of the laws of 2006, is amended to read as follows:

4 2. Prohibitions. An employer shall not take any retaliatory personnel 5 action against an employee because such employee does any of the follow-6 inq:

7 (I) discloses, or threatens to disclose to a supervisor or to a (a) 8 public body an activity, policy or practice of the employer that is in violation of law, rule or regulation which violation creates and 9 10 presents a substantial and specific danger to the public health or safety, or which constitutes health care fraud; OR 11

12 [(b)] (II) provides information to, or testifies before, any public body conducting an investigation, hearing or inquiry into any such 13 violation of a law, rule or regulation by such employer; or 14

15 [(c)] (III) objects to, or refuses to participate in any such activity, policy or practice in violation of a law, rule or regulation[.]; OR 16 (B) PROTESTS OR DISCLOSES, WHETHER TO A SUPERVISOR, A PUBLIC ENTITY, 17 OR TO THE PUBLIC IN GENERAL, ANY ACTION THAT CONSTITUTES A VIOLATION OF 18 SECTION SEVENTY-THREE, SEVENTY-THREE-A, SEVENTY-FOUR, SEVENTY-FIVE, OR 19 SEVENTY-SIX OF THE PUBLIC OFFICERS LAW OR SECTION 20 175.20, 175.25, 21 175.40, 195.20 OR ARTICLE TWO HUNDRED OF THE PENAL LAW. 22 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
