AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to authorizing boards of cooperative educational services to enter into contracts with public libraries for high-speed telecommunications services

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Paragraph h of subdivision 4 of section 1950 of the education law is amended by adding a new subparagraph 11 to read as follows: (11) TO ENTER INTO CONTRACTS WITH INDIVIDUAL PUBLIC LIBRARIES OR PUBLIC LIBRARY SYSTEMS FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING HIGH-SPEED TELECOM-MUNICATIONS SERVICES INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, HIGH-SPEED SERVICES. ANY SUCH PROPOSED CONTRACT SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE REVIEW AND COMMISSIONER, 7 THE WHO MAY ONLY APPROVAL OF APPROVE SUCH PROPOSED 8 CONTRACT WHEN, IN SUCH COMMISSIONER'S OPINION, SUCH CONTRACT: RESULT IN A MORE ECONOMICAL UTILIZATION OF EXISTING BOARDS OF COOPER-9 ATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES HIGH-SPEED TELECOMMUNICATIONS 10 SERVICES OR RESOURCES THAN WOULD BE ACHIEVED WERE SUCH CONTRACT NOT APPROVED; (B) 11 WILL NOT DISRUPT THE LEVEL OF SERVICES TO COMPONENT SCHOOL 12 AND (C) WILL RESULT IN A MORE ECONOMICAL UTILIZATION OF EXISTING LIBRARY 13 COMMISSIONER SHALL ISSUE A FINDING, IN WRITING, MAKING 14 RESOURCES. THE ANY DETERMINATION PURSUANT TO THIS SUBPARAGRAPH. 15 SUCH SERVICES 16 PUBLIC LIBRARIES AND LIBRARY SYSTEMS SHALL BE PROVIDED AT COST AND SHALL 17 NOT BE ELIGIBLE FOR AID PURSUANT TO SUBDIVISION FIVE OF THIS SECTION. 18 S 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth day after
