AN ACT in relation to village justices in the incorporated village of North Hills, county of Nassau

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any inconsistent provisions of any other general or special law, in the event the incorporated village of North Hills, county of Nassau, has two village justices, it may also by resolution or local law, provide for an additional acting village justice or in the event such village has one village justice, it may also by resolution or local law, provide for two acting village justices.

S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
